Fortescue Vocational Training and Employment (VTEC) provides training for guaranteed employment and hundreds of new career opportunities for Aboriginal people.

Eligibility:

- Identify as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander
- Be a permanent resident of Karratha or Roebourne area
- Must be 18 years of age or older

Fortescue VTEC engagement is targeted at local Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people with barriers to employment, such as drivers licence, health and wellbeing, numeracy and literacy, and more.

Fortescue's VTEC team works with community organisations to support applicants to overcome these barriers and join the VTEC Training Program.
