We'd like to thank all the supporters and sponsors of the event, past and present, including the great work done by the Nintirri Centre and all the volunteers.

We welcome, appreciate people discovering, and supporting all cultural events and Traditional Owner performers. We hope everyone remains safe and well, and look forward to more certainty in future celebrations of Banjima culture with you all.
